\$ 500.00 EDUCATIONAL BURSARY APPLICATION

Ottawa B Minor Hockey League (“OBMHL”) was created to support minor hockey players in the OBMHL. The “OBMHL Education Bursary Program” assists players seeking post-secondary education. The OBMHL Bursary will be given in recognition of outstanding commitment to community service, athletics and academics. This bursary reflects the achievements of a young hockey player who is committed to his or her community, athletic ability, and academic achievement. Each approved recipient will receive five hundred dollars (\$500.00) towards his or her post-secondary education. There will be a maximum of three (3) bursary recipients awarded per year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- All players up to eighteen years (18) of age, a registered player in the OBMHL within the 2025-2026 season and in good standing are eligible.
- You must be graduating from high school in 2026 and be accepted/enrolled in a post-secondary institution.
- If you are graduating from high school in 2026, you must be pursuing a career requiring further education or training (e.g. university, college, trade school etc.).
- Successful academic achievement.
- Active in their local community programs (any community sport or social program).

Complete the application form and required documentation (one sided only please) forward all the required documents to the OBMHL office to the attention of the Bursary Committee via email at bursary@ottawableague.ca.

All Applications will be provided to the bursary committee who will select the successful candidates based on the stated qualifications. All selections will be final.

The successful applicants will be notified by June 7, 2026. The decisions will be made by the OBMHL Bursary Committee and will not be subject to review.
